

## Phase 2: Indoor Services

After the meeting of the church leadership in July, we are moving into Phase 2. For the month of July, we will have one service at 10:30 am; which will be live streamed on Facebook.

It is important that you RSVP to attend our indoor service so that we can accommodate for the limitations the size of our space creates when complying with social distancing recommendations.

Below is what you need to know about meeting inside:

- Main doors will be open upon your arrival with a greeter outside on the sidewalk. Doors will close at the start of the service.
- Bring your own beverages and snacks as we will not have the water fountains turned on and not offering coffee and donuts.
- We recommend that you wear a mask into the building until you get to your seat and again when you leave the building. We have masks available for those who don't have a mask.
- We have arranged our space to accommodate for social distancing and ask that families sit together in the same row.
- We recommend that you walk directly to your seat and remain seated. There should be no loitering around in the building.
- At the conclusion of the service, we will excuse church attendees row-by-row in an orderly fashion. We ask that you remain seated and leave the church when excused. If you want to have a conversation with someone, please do it outside.
- We will have hand sanitizer throughout the building. We will have bulletins and other information laying on a table when you walk in the building, and it is up to you if you choose to pick it up.
- Bathroom usage is for 2 people at a time and we ask parents to accompany their kids.
- An offering plate will not be passed at this time. There is an offering box available or you can continue to give online.
